

Cybulski's chicken Cycle

Mrs. Cybulski's class learned about the life cycle of a chicken first hand by hatching incubating some Essex chicken eggs. Students began tracking the life cycle from day 1 and were able to study the inside mechanisms of an embryo inside of a chicken. After 21 days, Mrs. Cybulski's students were able to observe first hand when their chicken hatched. The students also studied why the chicks did not need be fed for 48 hours after hatching out of the egg.
