Girl Scouts

We had 9 girls last year who sold 1647 boxes (a per girl average of 183). This year we have 7 girls and are on track to sell about 2300, a per girl average of 328! Their initial goal was 252/girl (for a total troop goal of 1764) and right now we have 3 girls who have exceeded their personal goals and 2 others who are super close. Needless to say, school sales have been INSTRUMENTAL in those number.

In addition to the school booths and personal (ie family/friend) sales, the girls are encouraged to do "Walkabouts" in which they do individual door-to-door supervised sales to neighbors and local businesses and as a troop, they have also done several community booths at various Publix stores as well as Starbucks.

The girls want to use part of the proceeds to support the Coalition for the Homeless and will save a significant portion to pay for a trip to Savannah, GA in 2019 to visit Juliette Gordon Lows birthplace and learn more about the history of Girl Scouts.
