Our primary goal of implementing this reward program is that each and every student at Orlando Science feels encouraged and challenged to read. The "Blast Off with Books" program was created to encourage student reading through a rewards program and unite readers and the school. Readers are rewarded for the number of Accelerated Reader points (AR) and Sunshine State Books they read within a specific time period. AR Celebrations may vary from grade to grade. Parent volunteers are encouraged to help with celebrations, after being ADDitions approved.

We challenge students to read at least 10 Sunshine State Books and pass their AR tests for that book. The SSYRA is determined based off AR results.
