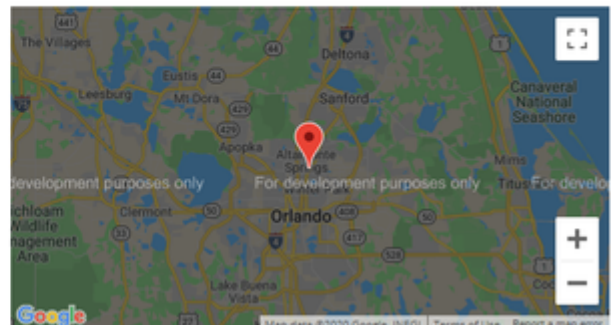

-Please be sure to check OSES Connect for any missing work. If you are unsure how to do this, please watch this video:

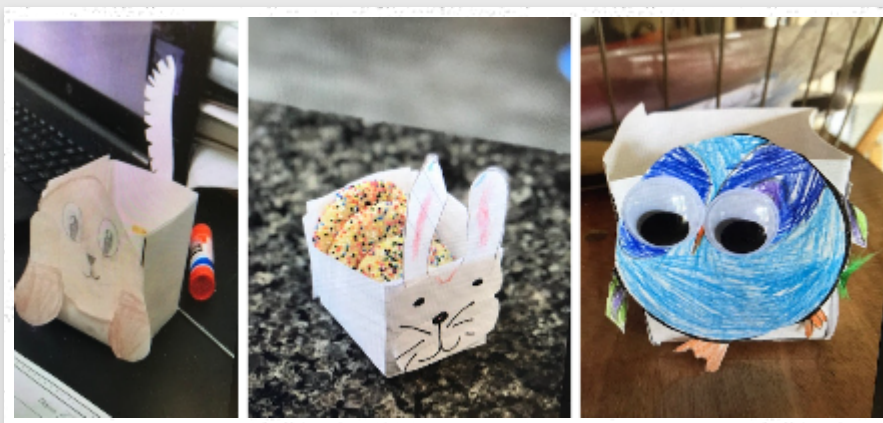
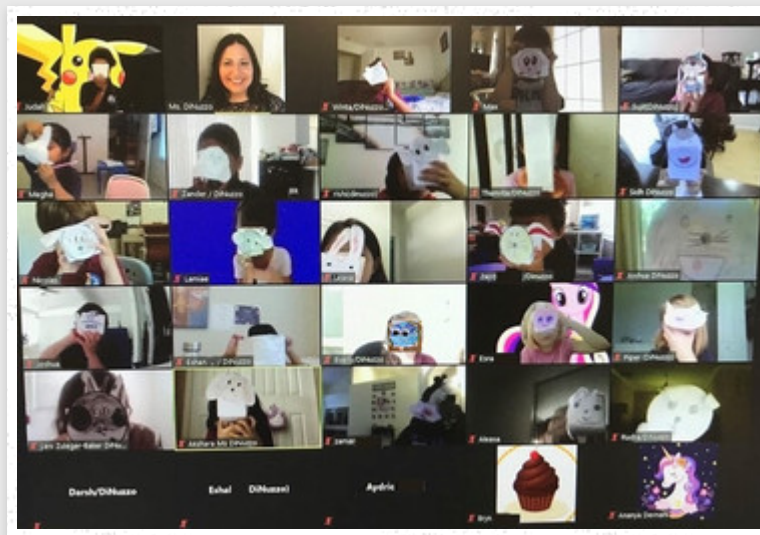

### STEM

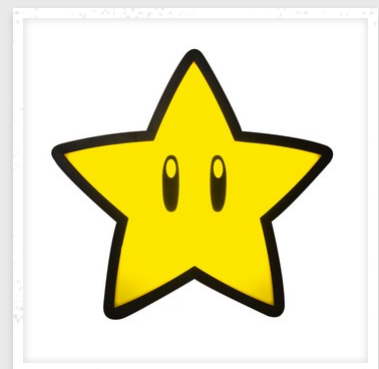
