OSES Dress Code Information

OSES uniforms should be purchased at **Risse Brothers**. Elementary students wear maroon or navy blue polo with the OSS logo and khaki or navy bottoms. Elementary students do not need P.E uniforms. Shoes must be closed-toed dress shoes, or athletic shoes. Not special designs, patterns (Checkered, plaid, camouflage, etc.) or wild colors are permitted. Shoes must be worn at all times. Belts must be leather, braided leather, or fabric in solid colors of black, brown, khaki or navy blue. For detailed uniform information, please see the Uniform Policy in the Students and Parents Handbook pages 28 –29.

Students are expected to wear the OSES uniform at all times and to dress and groom themselves in such a way as to reflect neatness, cleanliness, and safety.

Dress Code: Tops

Top Options: Polo shirt with school logo.

During winter time, long sleeve/turtleneck may be worn under the knit/polo shirt as long as it is the school appropriate color (blue, maroon, tan, black and white)





Dress Code: Pants

Pants and shorts must be either khaki or navy blue. They must have belt loops and a belt must be worn through the loops and fastened appropriately. Cargo pants or shorts are **not** allowed.







Dress Code: Skirts

Skirts must be either khaki or navy blue.







Dress Code: Shoes

Shoes must be closed toe dress or athletic style. No special designs or patterns (checkered, plaid, camouflage, etc.) or wild colors (fluorescent) are permitted.

The emphasis regarding shoes is safety. All shoelaces must be tied properly.

Slippers, flip-flops, boots, Uggs, and high-heeled shoes are not permitted.

Dress Code: Jackets (blue color only)



Dress Code: Fall/Winter

Additional fall /winter clothing, including jackets that violate the school dress code, winter hats, gloves, etc. may be worn, but must be removed upon entering the building and stored in the student's backpack.

It is very important to label all jackets and uniform clothing with the student's name and grade. In that way, if it is lost in the school, it can be returned to the right person.
