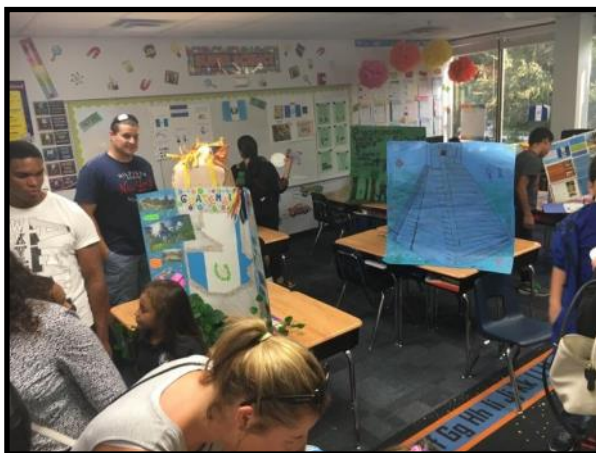
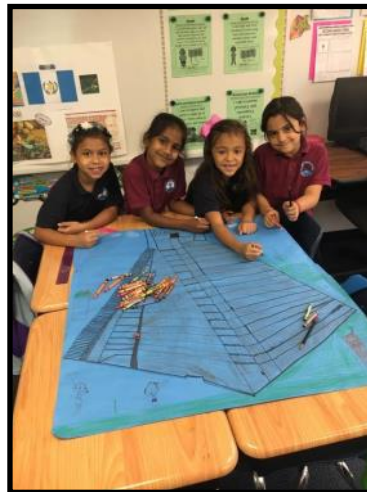
about their countries for Hispanic Heritage Night, including pottery, research projects, and coloring pages.

# 4th Grade

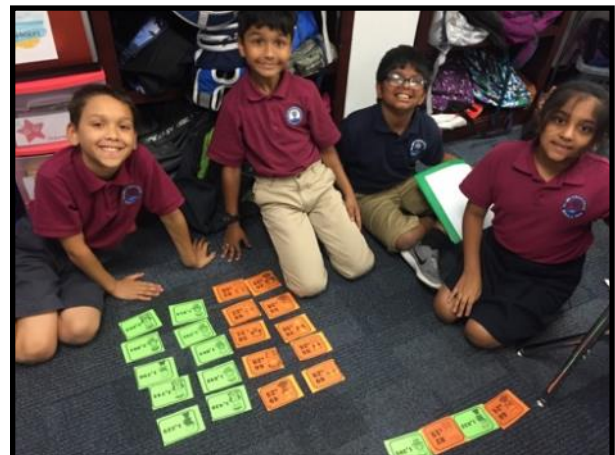
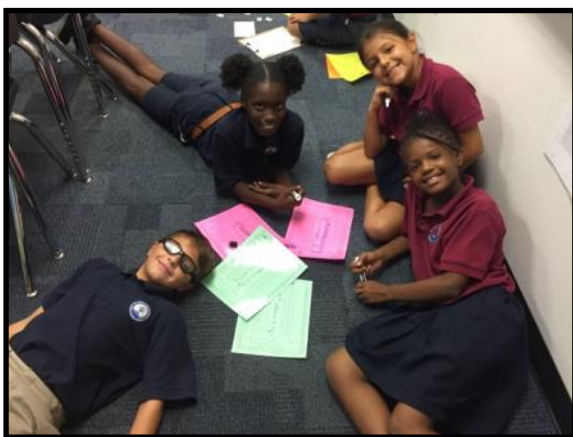

They continued their Fatal Fever read aloud and novel studies. All 4th grade classes have been focusing on how to write stellar introductory paragraphs in writing.



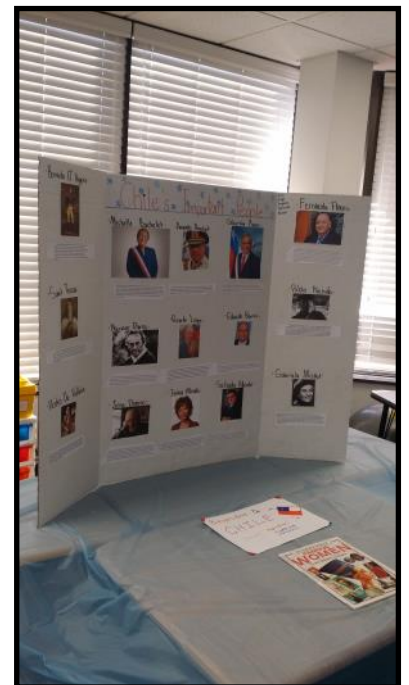
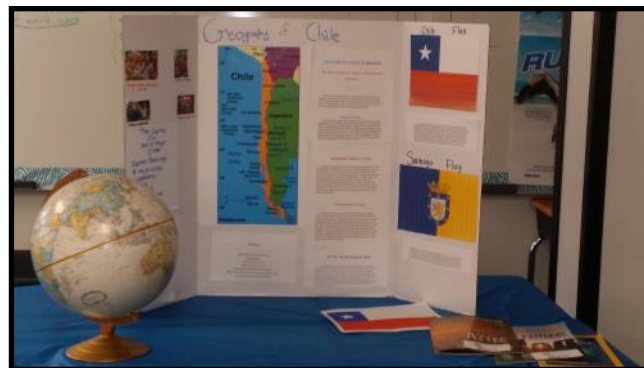
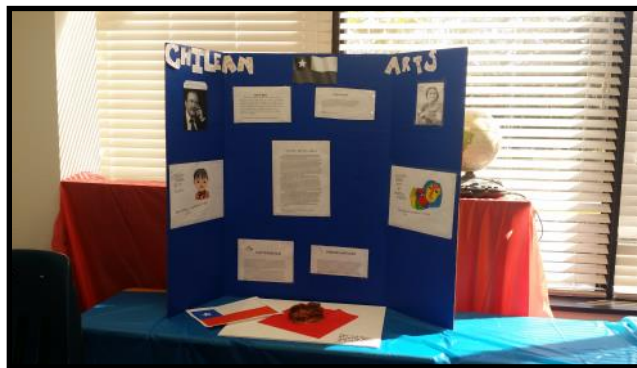
# 5th Grade

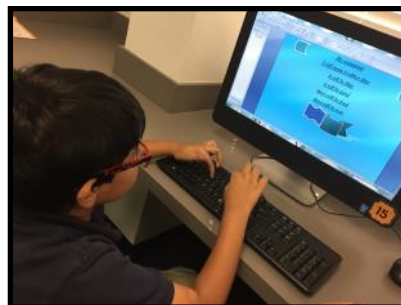
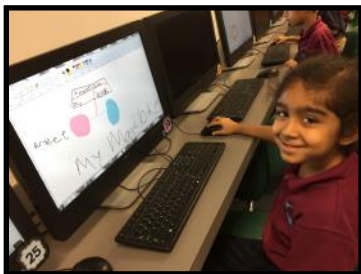
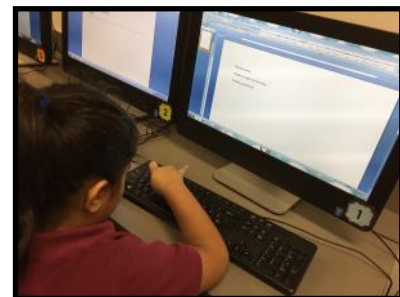
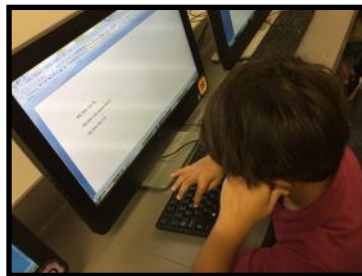
Kindergarten students have been learning how to use MS Paint Program and they drew their favorite pizza this week. All of their pizzas were looking very yummy!

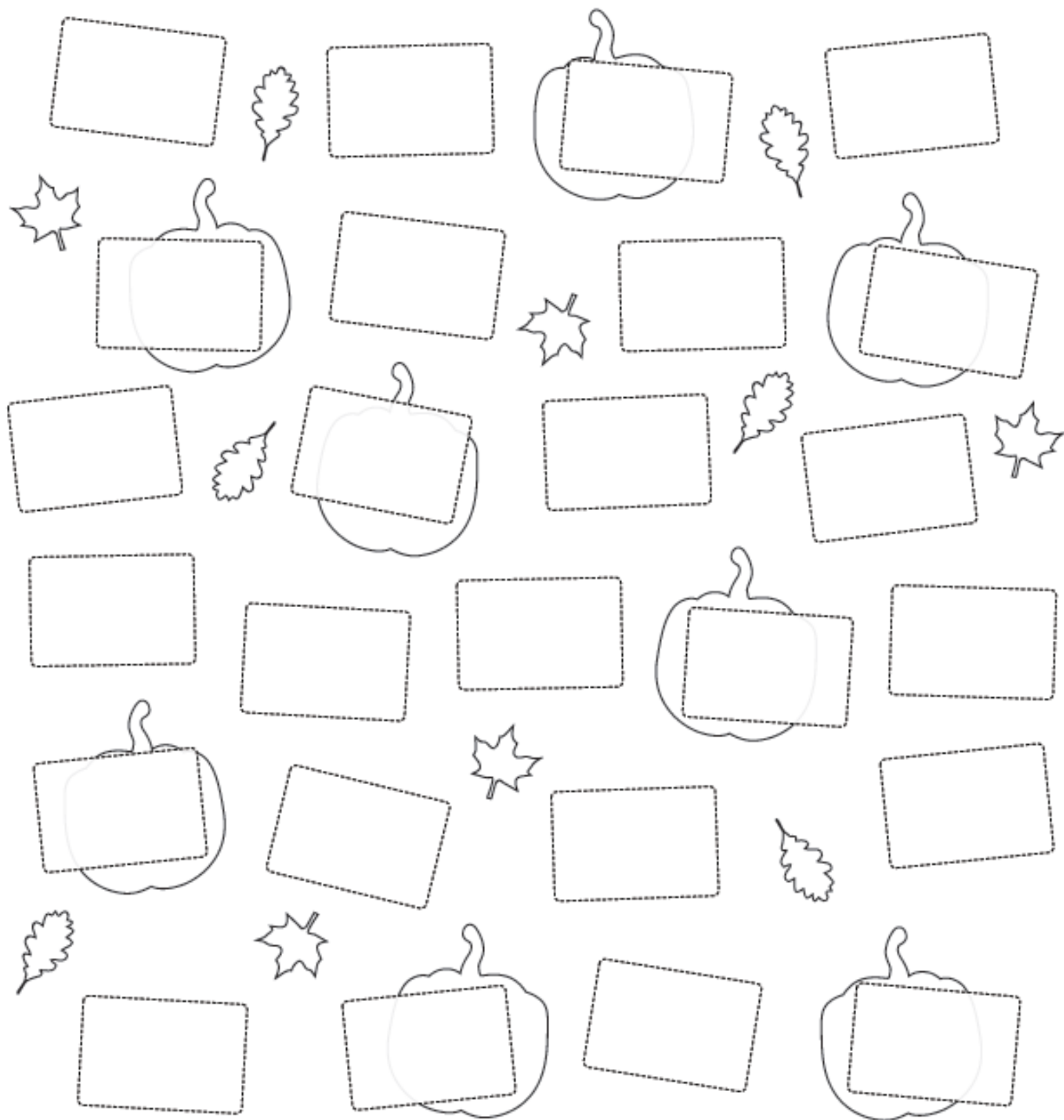
