Kindergarten

This week in kindergarten we have had a blast learning about the scientific method and exploring its different parts. After learning about the scientific method the students completed various science experiments so they had a chance to explore the scientific pro-

cess. In math students have been identifying various numbers and number patterns. They also learned how to use number lines and 100's charts to identify number sequences. We have started our fairy tale unit in reading. Students read various versions of classic fairy tales and they

recreate these fairy tales through plays and other activities. Students have been working very hard to learn about their designated country for Hispanic Heritage Night. Don't forget to come out for the event and see what we have been working on!



1st Grade

In Ms. Anderson and Ms. Swank's phonics and spelling, we read and wrote words with blends. In writing we completed activities related to Hispanic Heritage Night. In science and social studies, we did some fur-

ther exploration of our country, a brief exploration of some topics related to space, and a STEM challenge on Friday.:) In math we have practiced breaking apart a number to make a ten as an addition and subtraction strategy. In Ms. Strickland and Mrs. Ortiz's

classes, we're working on retelling stories and story elements, silent E and long vowels, adjectives- we've been doing a writing project where we create our own planets. For math we're adding and subtracting using different strategies to solve problems.

This week Mrs. Silvares' and Mrs. Cybulski's classes learned about median, mode, and range. In order to practice, they did a Skittles group work activity. In reading, they finished reading

folktale! The student's also illustrated a famous Mayan temple, the Tikal, and the country's flag, by hand! Ms. Haines' class studied Panama and built stop-motion models of the Panama Canal! Mrs. Bonnell's class researched Venezuela, and they learned about the world's tallest waterfall,

Angel Falls. Mrs. Nelson's class has been learning about Peru all week, and wrote paragraphs to go along with their Machu Picchu art piece.

4th Grade

4th grade was a buzz this week learning about Hispanic Culture! All the classes learning about different countries and doing group projects. We are all excited to share our projects at Hispanic Heritage Night!

Miss Chardavoyne's class learned about Spain the past 2 weeks and completed group projects about the Spanish culture.

In reading they read The Librarian of Basra and how to sequence the events of a story.




fine arts, geography, food and clothing, the history, and important people in the country. Students presented their projects for their

Kindergarten students have been learning how to use MS Paint Program and they drew their favorite pizza this week. All of their pizzas were looking very yummy!




