

Study Island 2018 Summer Academic Sprints Competition

Every year, Edmentum does a Study Island Competition to encourage students to continue practicing their skills over the summer. This past summer Ms. Hurley entered our school into the competition. A total of 219 schools and 12, 574 students nation wide participated in the 2018 summer competition. There were two ways to win:

- Most Questions Correct: The top student from each grade span (K-5, 6-8, 9-12) won if they had the most questions answered with at least 60% correct overall.
- Consistent Practice: Two winners were randomly chosen from the group of students that answered 20 or more questions for at least 8 of the 11 weeks.

Congratulations to our very own Xitlaly Gutierrez who won the most questions correct category for the K-5 grade span. She answered 4,521 questions during the 11-week competition. Her prize for winning the competition was a Fire tablet and a pizza party. Honorable mention also went to Aarish Ali who answered 4,300 questions during that time period.
