



# **HEALTH AND WELLNESS**

For the health and safety of all our students, please keep your child home when any of the following signs/symptoms are noted, and seek medical attention as needed. The following signs and symptoms may indicate the beginning of a communicable disease:

\*sore throat \* red eye(s) - itchy, crusty, yellow discharge
\*headache \* nausea
\*diarrhea (two or more times) \* vomiting (two or more times)
\*fever (100.5 degrees F or more) \* coughing/wheezing
\*balding/flaky area with/without patches \* chills
\*red, swollen areas

Parents of child in school with any of the above symptoms will be notified. In order to prevent illness from being spread to other children in the school, students can **only return to school when symptoms are resolved and has been fever free for 24 hours** *without* the use of fever **medication as** <u>per OCPS policy</u>.

\*If your child needs to take any medication throughout the day, it MUST be checked into the clinic first. Students may not carry medicine in their backpack unless approved by Ms. Toro.
