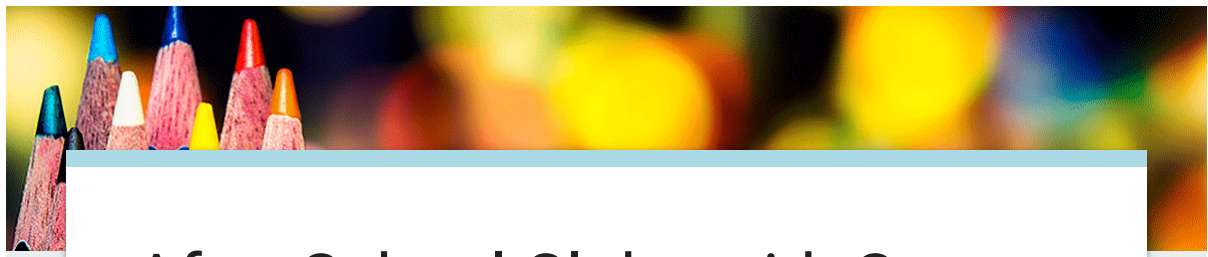

This week in 3rd grade, students are starting to learn about different biomes for our upcoming biome day. Each class will decorate their room and we will have rotations to learn facts about each biome.

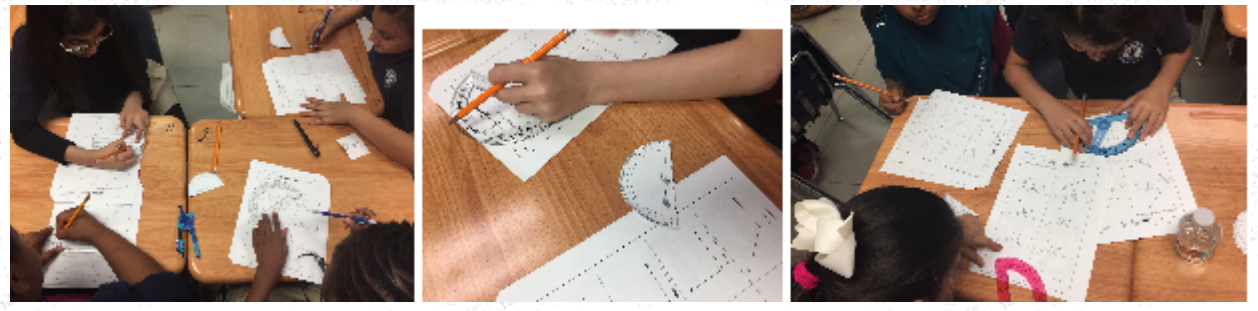
All of our students enjoyed Orca Day. Classes did rotations to help learn more about our school's core values.

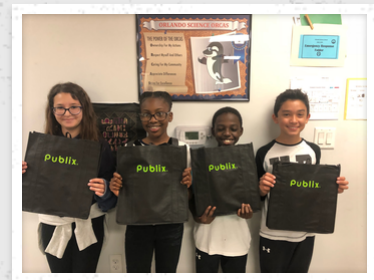
Press's class has been working with measuring angles using all of the various methods that might be on the FSA.

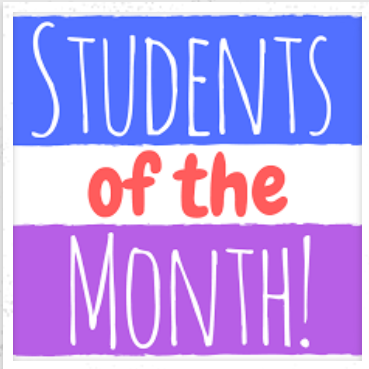

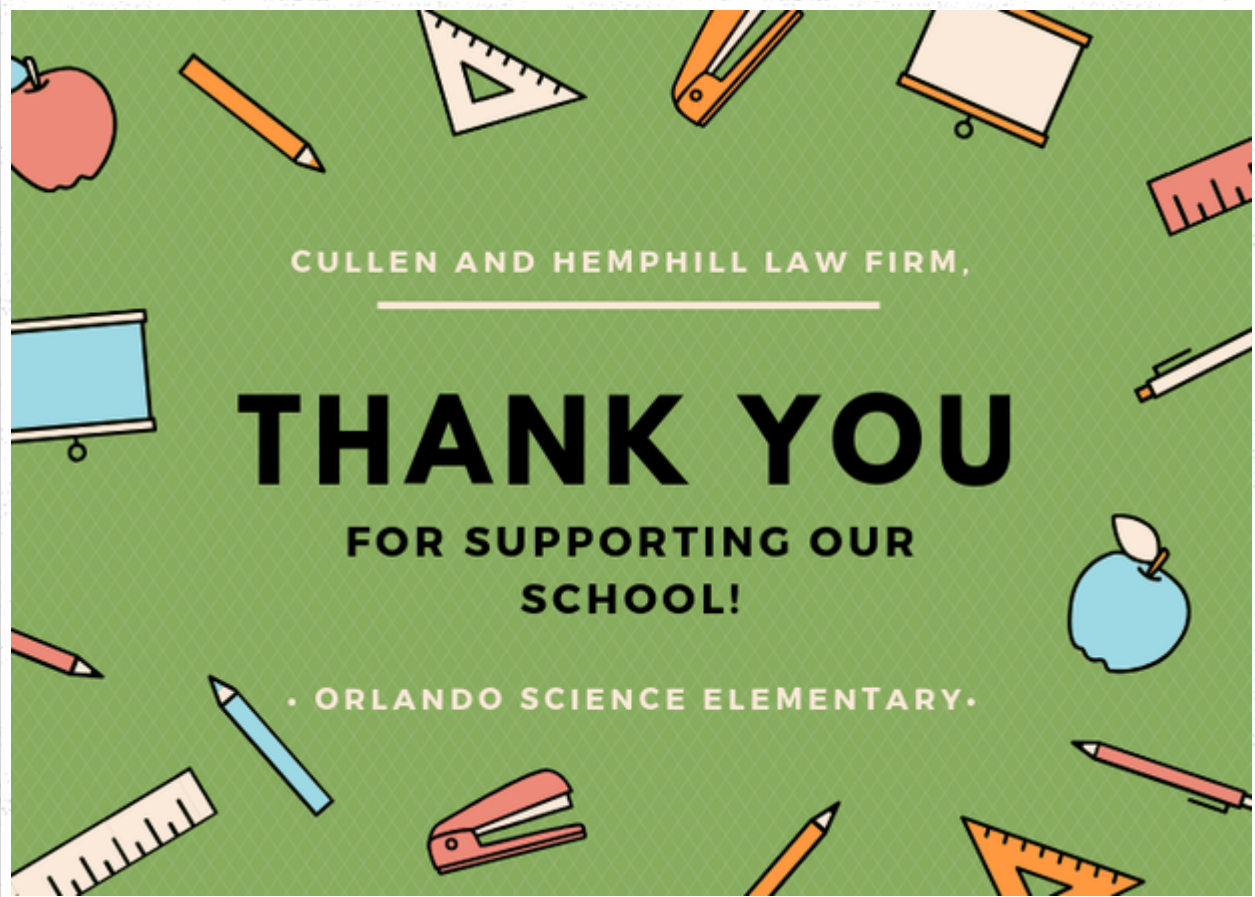
