



This week Mrs. Beckman's class began a book study on the chapter book "Monster In The Mangroves". In math we began a new unit on 2D shapes. Have a super weekend!






THIRD GRADE

Permission slips for our field trip to Fun Spot are due by **May 3**. Please ask your teacher if you need another one.








FOURTH GRADE

SIXTH GRADE









