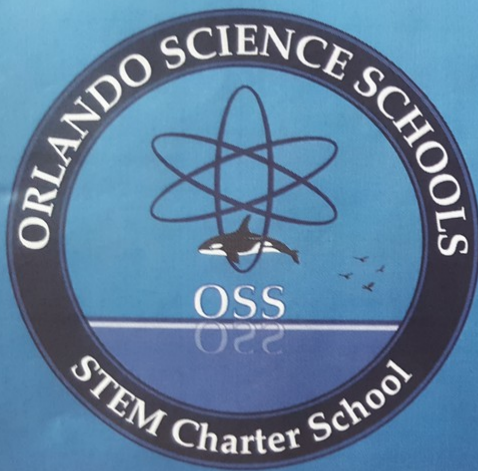

The FSA Math test will be on **May 6 and 7**. Please make sure our students are well rested, eat a good breakfast and are ready to do their best!

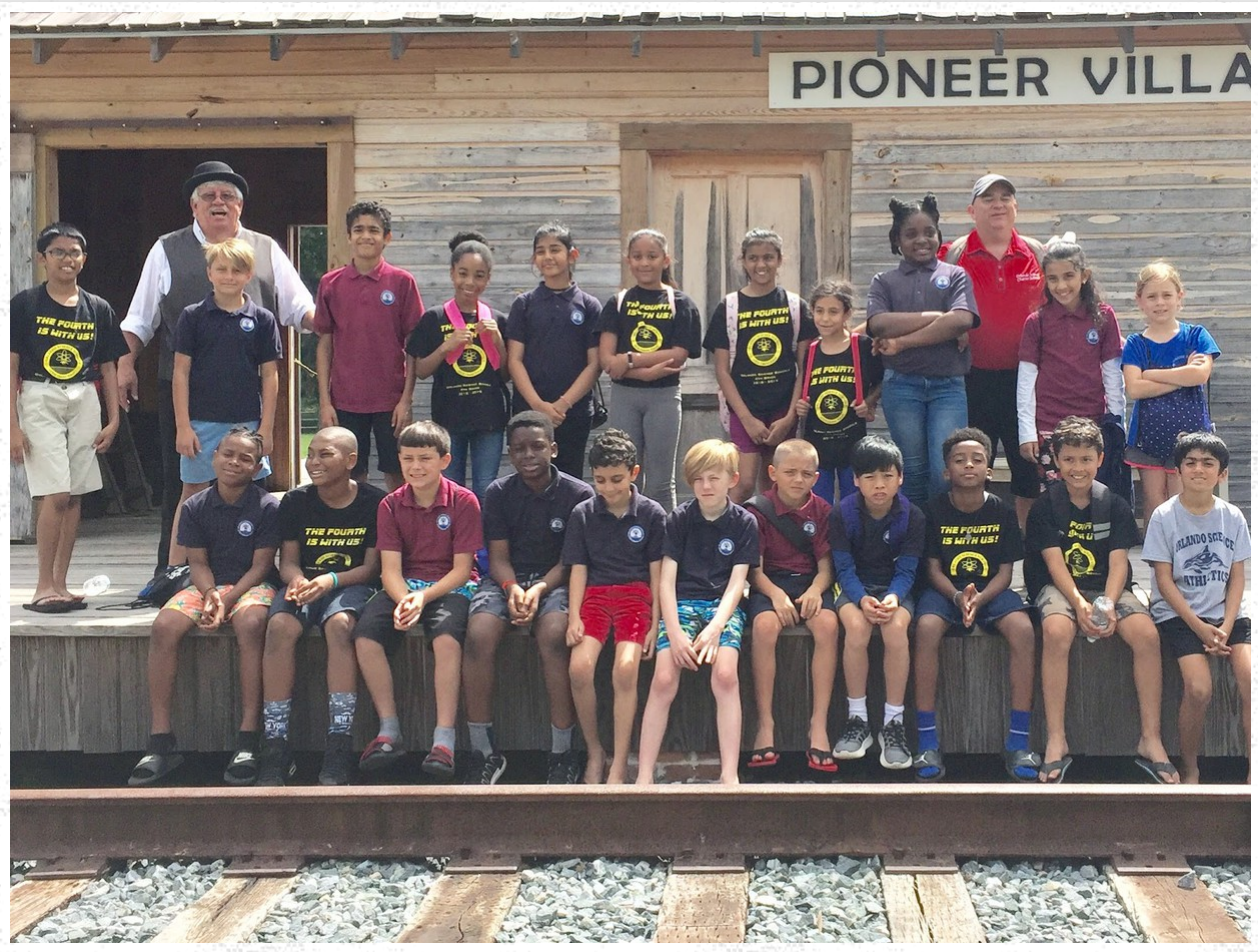

FIFTH GRADE

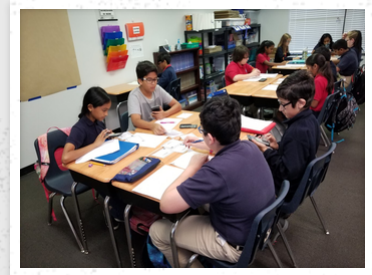

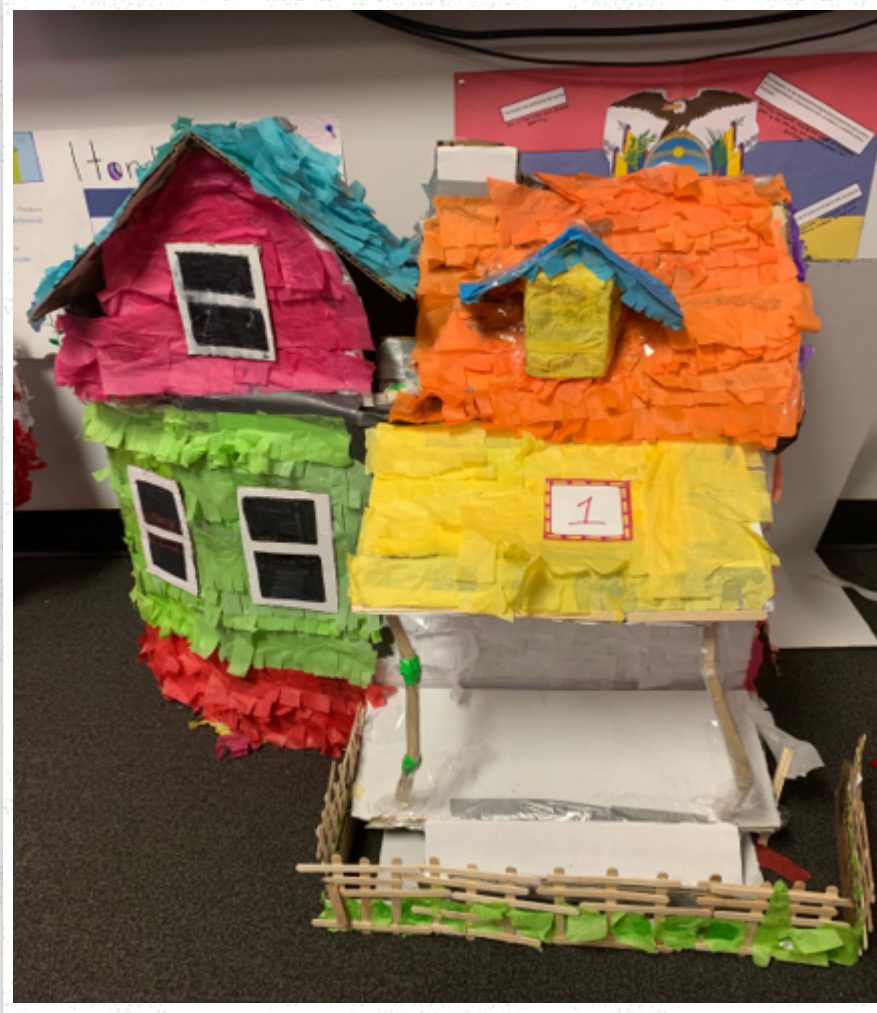
SIXTH GRADE

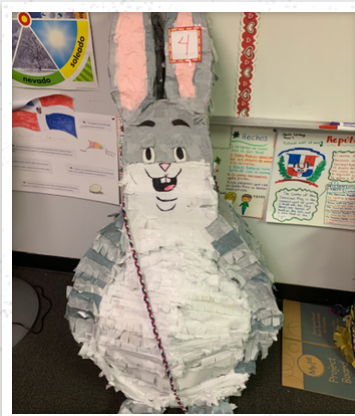

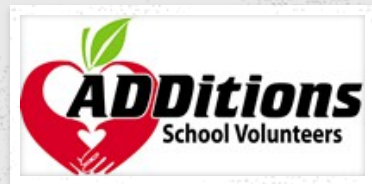

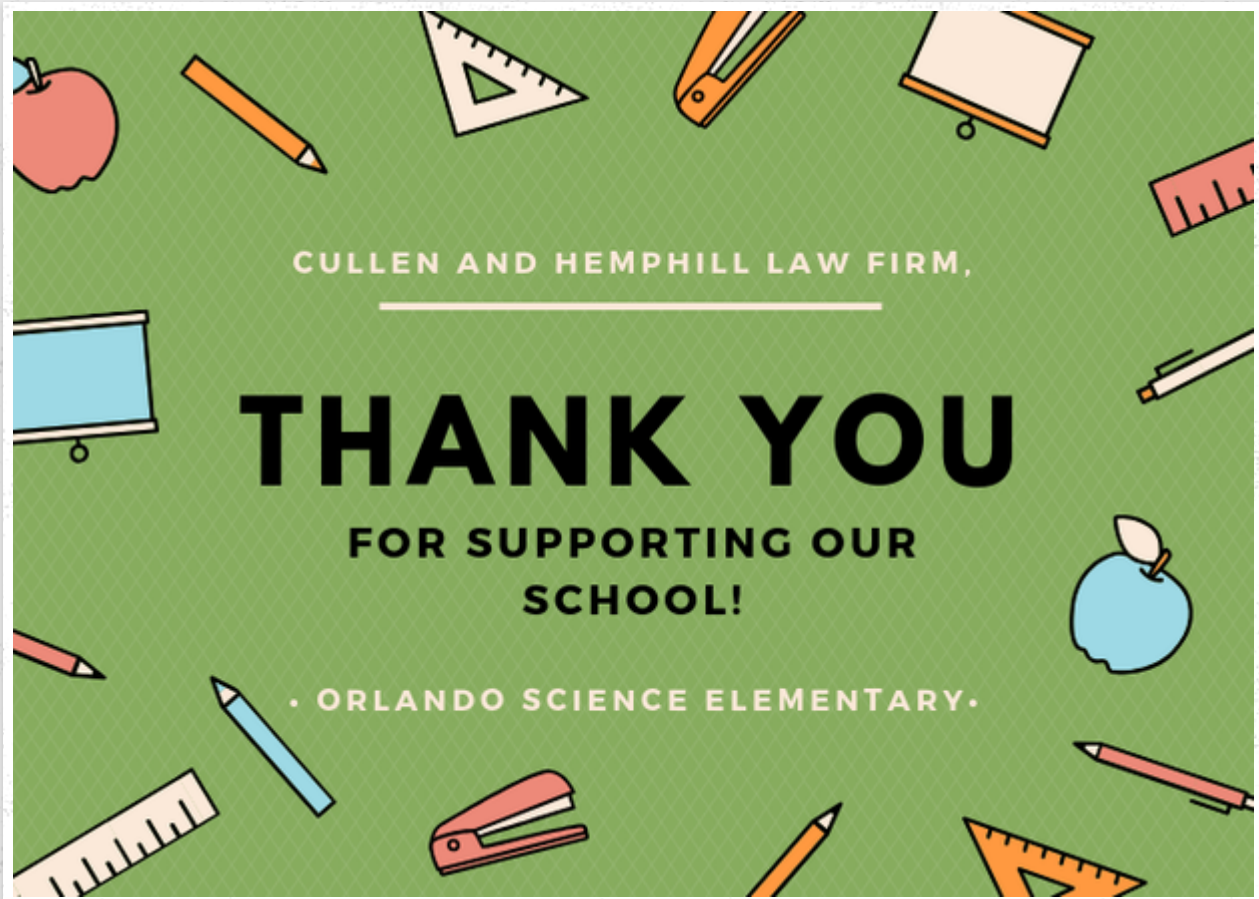
