## Our Science Olympiad Team Won 1st Place at Regional's

Regional competition for Science Olympiad was held at Lake Nona Middle School on Saturday, January 18th. We would like to congratulate the Orlando Science Schools Science Olympiad Team and their head coach, Mr. Demir, for winning first place overall among 20 other teams. There were 23 events and we received 10 first place medals, 4 second place medals and 4 third place medals. This is an amazing accomplishment - placing in the top 3 for 18 of the 23 events. Our teams work very hard to prepare for this competition. There were 32 middle school students who participated. Some of the events include Anatomy, Boomilever, Heredity, Meteorology, Road Scholar, Robo Cross, Simple Machines, Solar System and Water Quality. Now, the team will begin to prepare for the State Competition on March $15^{\text {th }}$ which will be held at UCF. We would like to thank the teachers and parent volunteers who are part of this success as well.
