

Guidelines for the 8th Grade End of the Year Field Trip—Gradventure

- To attend the field trip, students must have a GPA of a 2.5.

- Students must have transportation when they return from the trip.
- Students must not owe any money to the school.
- No office referrals for third quarter until the field trip day (January 16- May 8).
- No ISS for third quarter until the field trip day (January 16-May 8).
- Students must follow OSS dress down dress code. ANY STUDENT NOT FOLLOWING DRESSCODE WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ATTEND THE TRIP (no clothing that has holes or shredding or offensive language, no visible tank tops, undershirts, or undergarments, no exposed mid-drifts or clothing that is too revealing, no chains, spiked collars or belts, or accessories that may be used as weapons, etc.).


