CLUB ACTIVITIES:

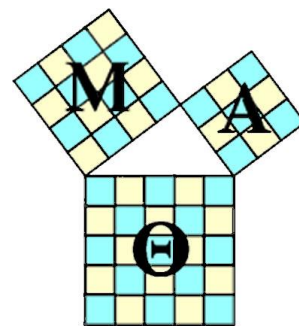
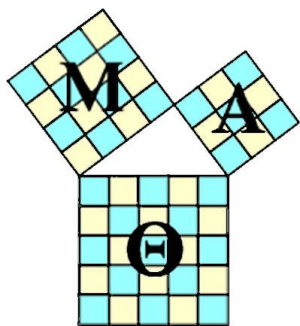
