- Competition Clubs have higher fees and attendance is mandatory.
- Invitation only clubs have requirements that will need to be met to be able to participate in the club.

7th – 8th Grade Club Descriptions

Monday

Badminton One time club fee: \$30

One time club fee \$100

Members of FBLA will be expected to compete at the district level, as well as the state competitive events (if they place).

Marine Biology

One time club fee \$50

Students will learn about marine science and the effects on the state of Florida through activities, mini labs, readings, videos and more. Students will learn how they can collect data and input the data into a database. Students will be able to collect data at our school to input into a database. We will host guest speakers virtually. Students will participate in Marine Science competitions and adopt marine animals. Students will participate in growing marine plants for UCF.

NJHS

One time club fee \$50

The National Junior Honor Society (NJHS) is the nation's premier organization established to recognize outstanding high school and middle level students. More than just an honor roll, NJHS serves to honor those students who have demonstrated excellence in the areas of Scholarship, Leadership, Service, Character, and Citizenship. These characteristics have been associated with membership in the organization since their beginning in 1929. This club is invitation only.

Robotics

One time club fee \$250

Robotics club is a gathering of students who are interested in learning about and working with robots. This club is an invitation only club that will meet on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays. Applications are in the Newsletter.

Spanish Spelling Bee/Spanish Club

One time club fee \$20

Students will learn the basic rules of ultimate frisbee and practice playing the sport during club time.

Tuesday

Boys Flag Football

One time club fee \$30

Students will learn the basic rules of flag football and practice playing the sport during club time.

Creative Writing Club

One time club fee \$10

This club is designed for students to explore different methods of writing and expression.

Girls Who Code

One time club fee \$10

Girls Who Code is an international non-profit organization that aims to close the gender gap in technology by inspiring, educating, and equipping girls and nonbinary students with the computing skills needed for 21st-century opportunities.

Music Club

Music Club is for scheduled band and orchestra members only. This is an opportunity to complete the three days of practice required for the students' weekly practice log and receive individual feedback from Ms. Terlizzese. This practice time has to be initiated by Ms. Terlizzese, in order to count towards their practice log requirement. Please remember the

course itself has a \$50 fee that is separate from the club. The club is completely free for the students.

Odyssey of the Mind

One time club fee \$50

Odyssey of the Mind, abbreviated OM or OotM, is a creative problem-solving program where team members present their solution at a competition to a predefined long-term problem that takes many months to complete and involves writing, design, construction, and theatrical performance.

Science Olympiad

One time club fee \$350

Earth Space Topics including Astronomy/Solar System and Meteorology. Topics include the Weather: Extreme Weather, Climate Patterns and Forecasting, and Space: The History, Cosmology, Astrophysics and Astrobiology! Physical Science: Crave the Wave. Understanding properties and interactions of waves, types of waves and waves through mediums. In order to be a part of this club, the students will have to have this course on their schedule. This club will meet on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Volleyball

One time club fee \$30

One time club fee \$20
