

End of the Year Reminders

Dear Parents and Guardians,

As the end of the 2015-2016 School Year Approaches, OSS has a few important reminders that need to be addressed:

1. **Upcoming 7th Graders:** You must get your 7th grade immunizations before next school year. An original copy of the immunization document must be brought to the school registrar before school starts. If you do not supply OSS with this document you will not be given a class schedule for the 2016-2017 School Year.
2. **All Students:** Must get a physical before the 2016-2017 school year. An original copy of the physical must be brought to the school registrar before school starts. If you do not supply OSS with these documents you will not be given a class schedule for the 2016-2017 School Year.
3. **New Address:** If you moved or changed your address. You must fill out the first two pages of the enrollment forms. If you need these forms please contact Ms. Smith and she will provide them to you. They are also located on our school website, under the TAB "Enrollment Forms" on the left hand side. An original copy of your lease must be brought to the school registrar before school starts. You will also need correct proof of Orange County Domicile. If you do not supply OSS with this document you will not be given a class schedule for the 2016-2017 School Year.
4. **Medication Pick UP:** Medication/inhalers, etc. that are located at the front office must be picked up by June 8th 2016. Any medications not picked up by this date will be properly disposed of.
5. **2016-2017 Emergency Contact Forms:** Please be advised that **ALL STUDENTS** will be required to turn in a completed "**2016-2017 Emergency Contact form**". These forms are not optional; if the form is not supplied to OSS by open house you will not be given a class schedule for the 2016-2017 School Year. You may find this form on our website under the "Enrollment Form" tab on the left hand side; it is located on page five and six. You will need to fill out both pages. Forms may be given to Ms. Smith once they are complete.
6. **Business Envelope and Stamp Required:** We will be mailing your student's state test scores and final report cards once they arrive to you over the summer. It is required that **every** student bring in a business envelope, stamp and the below form before June 8th 2016. Please do not self-address the envelope. Ms. Smith will take care of that for you. Please make sure all items on the below form are filled out correctly. Ms. Smith will also send home a blank "2016-2017 Emergency Contact Form" in your envelope as well.

2016-2017 Document Reminders

Dear Parents and Guardians,

The following items are required in order to receive a 2016-2017 class Schedule at Open House, please understand that these are an OCPS requirement and they are required by every student. Once you read through the entire list, please sign and return the bottom form to Ms. Smith along with the "OSS Envelope Information Form", a blank business envelope and stamp.

- **Upcoming 7th Grade Immunization Documents:** Original Copy due to School Registrar by Open House.
- **New Address:** If you moved, you must fill out the first two pages of the enrollment documents. An original copy of your lease must be brought to the school registrar before school starts. You will also need a correct proof of Orange County Domicile. You may find the enrollment document forms on our website under the "Enrollment Form" tab on the left hand side.
- **School Physical:** All students are required to have an updated School Physical on file. These physicals are different than "sports physicals". An original copy of the physical must be brought to the school registrar. Please note these physical given on a yearly basis for example if your student received their physical in September of 2015 then they will be due for their annual physical of September 2016.
- **2016-2017 Emergency Contact Form:** Please be advised that **ALL STUDENTS** will be required to turn in a completed "**2016-2017 Emergency Contact form**". These forms are not optional; if the form is not supplied to OSS by open house you will not be given a class schedule for the 2016-2017 School Year. You may find this form on our website under the "Enrollment Form" tab on the left hand side; it is located on page five and six. You will need to fill out both pages. Forms may be given to Ms. Smith once they are complete.

Please tear off the below portion and return it with the "OSS Envelope Information Form" and contents. The first 7th period class that returns all of their forms and contents will earn a free dress down day. All forms are due no later than June 8th 2016.




