



Jr Florida Lego League (Jr FLL) Robotics

FIRST LEGO League (Jr FLL) is a robotics team designed to get children excited about science and technology and teach them valuable employment and life skills. Teams of six, guided by Parent Coaches, use LEGO® bricks to build a model that is programmed to move, complete a research project about Space, go on field trips, listen to guest speakers, develop a Show Me trifold to illustrate their journey, and compete against other Jr. FLL teams around Central Florida. Parent participation is mandatory. Fees will go towards the kit, registration, and some of the competition fees. A coaches training will be held shortly after school begins to help prepare parents for their roles and responsibilities this year. All teams are required to compete in at least one event. There is a selection process, starting with an online survey, contracts for both parents and students, and the team formation. Two coaches are required for each team of six students. If there is no coach, there is no team. Most, if not all, team meetings will be held OFF campus.
